There's a lady in a powered wheelchair who had to go down the road with traffic coming her way just to get to the sidewalk. And I remember seeing a lady driving a car with a handicap tag coming towards her just before the lady made it to the sidewalk. The lady in the wheelchair was struck by a car some years ago that took out both of her knees. She rides one with the Orange flag on it. I'm sure the city wouldn't mind putting in the rest of the sidewalk especially for the clinic, and on both sides of the road with plenty of crosswalk markings and signs.

I replied to him the following:

Sidewalks are the responsibility of the property owner. The city is using the tax funds to replace sidewalks. There is a form at LittleRock.org to request to be added to the list which is currently booked until 2016. I will forward this on to Public Works and due to the Health Clinic and being located on a State Highway maybe we can get it moved to a priority list. What is your email and I will cc' you.
